PRINCIPAL'S CORNER

Dear PVES Family,

Creating a safe environment at school begins from the moment you drop your child off until they are picked up at the end of the day. Here are some safety tips to remember during morning drop off:

- When using the valet service in the front of the school, always have your child exit on the curb side of the car
- Never double park in the parking lot
 - It creates blind spots that are very dangerous for your child
 - It is a \$363 ticket
- Do not park in the red zone – this area is for emergency vehicles only
 - “No Parking” has been painted on the red curb
 - It is a \$363 ticket

Thank you to those of you who are walking, riding the shuttle, riding your bike, scooter, or skateboard to school, you help reduce traffic. If you ride a bike, scooter, or skateboard once you are on the sidewalk by our library, please walk to the rack or pick up your skateboard. This will keep pedestrians safe.

During pick up, please be aware that there are no parking signs posted for our valet area. You are able to wait in your car but you are not able to park your car and leave it during this time. Again this is a very expensive ticket!

Last year the parking authority came several times in the afternoon and many of our families received tickets. While the school does not call them, they do drop by unexpectedly from time to time.

Children learn so much more from watching what we do than from the words we say. Set a good example and follow the safety rules and laws that apply to our parking lot so we can keep your child safe throughout the day.
