Here are the new boundaries. Zone 1 children attend PVES and includes One West Bluff and goes to McConnell Ave. Zone 2 children reside in a zone of choice and choose from eight elementary schools. They must complete a zone of choice application. This zone begins at McConnell and ends at Westlawn Ave. Zone 3 children will attend Playa del Rey Elementary. This zone includes families living between Westlawn and Campus Center Drive. Again, if you currently attend PVES you will grandfathered into PVES and your child may continue to attend PVES until they matriculate to 6th grade.

March 6th through March 10th is spring parent conferences week. During this week you'll be asked to sign up to meet with your teacher. Our dismissal time will be different this week to allow for the conferences. Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday school is out at 2:00 and on Tuesday we dismiss at the usual time of 1:36.
