Thank you to our seven parent volunteers who will have their names included in our School Site Safety Plan and are accompanying us on our drill this Thursday.


During our practice drills we learned that our older students make it to the park in a little over 15 minutes while our kindergarten students take about 30 minutes. So, the upper grade students will leave first followed by the other grades in descending order. This emergency drill is meant to prepare us in the event of a failure of our methane gas system or other catastrophic event that would make our school site and the adjacent Sports Park, an unsafe place to be. Thank you for your support and cooperation as we add this action plan to our toolbox of safety procedures.





Dear Transitional Kindergarten, Kindergarten, First Grade, and New Parents,

When our school first opened, parents purchased an emergency kit for their child. These kits were placed in our Emergency Supply Bin that is on our playground. Now it is time for you to be asked to do the same so that each child will have individual supplies in addition to the supplies that have been purchased for the entire school.

The kits contain:

- **1 food bar – 2,400 calories**
- **6 water pouches**
- **1 emergency blanket**
- **1 light stick**
- **9 wet wipes**

These are the needed items to sustain one person for three days and **the cost is \$8 per child.**
