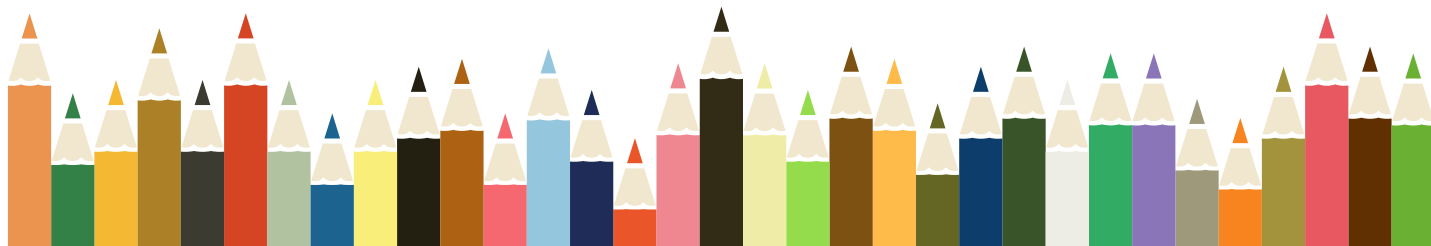


Dear Playa Vista Family,

The Great Shake Out is coming! On Thursday, October 18, at 10:18 PVES will participate in the statewide earthquake preparedness drill, the Great Shake Out. We'll be testing our Disaster Readiness Plan to make sure that all of our students would be safe in the event of a major earthquake.

Here's how it works. On 10/18 at 10:18 I'll announce that we are experiencing an earthquake and that everyone should drop and cover. After about a minute the all clear will be given and the entire school will evacuate to the assembly area on the playground. Once everyone has evacuated our Search and Rescue teams will deploy to search for unaccounted for students and/or staff. We plan on having a few upper grade children be "injured" giving us the opportunity to practice rescuing students who are not able to walk. Ms. Ashely will be manning the triage area and treating our "injured" students.

Parents are part of the drill as well. If you are on campus during the Shake Out you'll go to the assembly area to stay with students. If you are at home you can come over and help out in a different way. On the day of the drill you'll see two large signs go up that say Request Gate and Reunion Gate. In the event of a real disaster parents would go to the request gate (a gate leading to the service yard next to the valet line) to say you're here to pick up your child. A slip with your child's name on it will be filled out by Jackie Nelson and given to a runner. The runner will go to the assembly area to direct your child to the reunion gate where Kristina will have you sign your child out from school. We ask that you and your child then wait by the reunion gate that leads to the Sports Park for the all clear. Once the all clear is given, your child

Thank you for following these safety rules. (and remember that students are not wearing their costumes during the school day this year!)

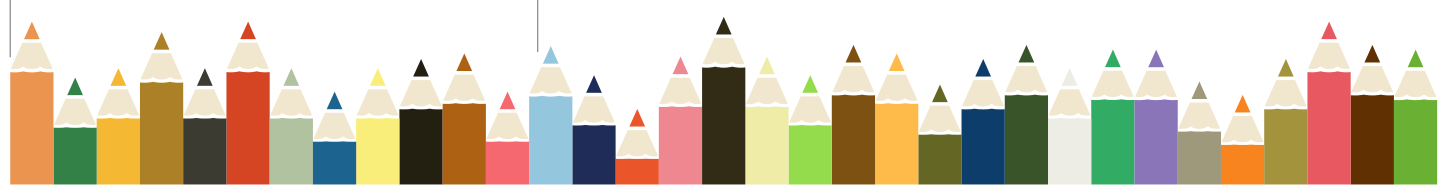
will return to class. So, if you're able to, come on over a little after 10:18, go to the request gate and participate in the Great Shake Out!
