United Teachers Los Angeles (UTLA) has announced that teachers will be on strike beginning Monday, January 14th. PVES will remain open during the strike. As a parent, it is your personal decision whether to send your child/children to school. As always, the safety of our students is my top priority and will continue to be so during the work stoppage.

All of our teachers will be walking the strike line in front of the school and no substitutes have been assigned to PVES. This means that all students will be with me in the MPR. We do have two people from the district's main office assigned to help out here at PVES. One of whom is certificated. Her name is Mrs. Peeks and she will be supporting our youngest students.

Some of the TAs, Ms. Mena, a Planet Bravo instructor, our campus aides, as well as Coach K from Playworks, will also be on campus. This means, however, that the student to

adult ratio will not be the same as it is during a routine day. The children, for the most part, will be with me in the MPR.

There are lessons planned and all of us on campus will do our best to ensure that the continuity of learning continues. These will not be ordinary days but instruction will continue and be standards based and grade level appropriate.
