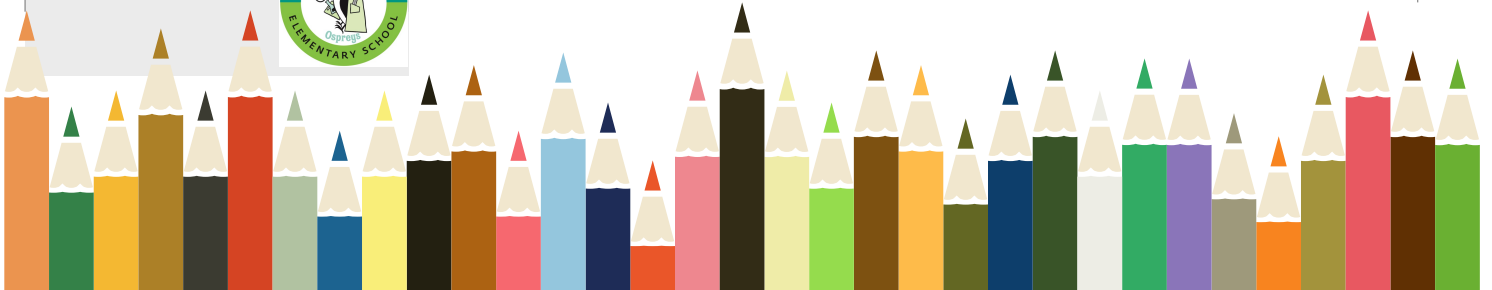
Dear PVES Family,

Motown is celebrating its 60th anniversary! Motown was founded on January 12, 1959 by Berry Gordy Jr. **This year's theme for Black History Month here at PVES is A Celebration of Music and Dance!** During the month of February students are going to study the roll that music and dance have played in African-American history. They will also be preparing for our culminating event on Thursday, February 28th. Stay tuned for more details coming soon!

Hydroponic gardening has come to PVES! There are three aeroponic towers at the end of the outdoor stage, I'm sure you've noticed them. These towers use hydroponics to grow a variety of different lettuces that have a five to six week growth cycle.

Our 4th and 5th grade students will be working with, **LETTUCE GROW** a neighborhood company that is expanding to include elementary schools in their educational programs. **Once a week a farmer is scheduled to come and check on the nutrient and ph levels in the towers.** Our 5th grade students will be assisting in this task during the first growth cycle and 4th grade will participate in the second cycle. When the lettuce is ready to be harvested, it will be donated to a local food bank.

Thank you to everyone who has already signed up for **The Rock, Roll, and Run for Education!** We're off to a strong start! This event is sponsored by the LAX Coastal Education Foundation in partnership with LMU and takes place on **March 9th.** Remember that the Rock, Roll and Run is a 5K/1K run that happens **on the LMU campus** and includes community booths, games, family-friendly activities, \$5 pancake breakfast (while supplies last), music, and more!





The Rock, Roll, and Run is an opportunity for the community at large to come together for a single purpose, supporting our schools. Be sure to sign up and participate in the run!

It's math time! Last week's problem was a series of numbers and you were asked to complete the series by finding the missing the number. The numbers were: 1944, 648, 108, 12, ? The number that finishes the pattern is the number one. Here's why.

The first number is divided by 3 with a quotient that is then divided by 6 and the next quotient is then divided by 9 and the last quotient, 12, is then divided by 12. So, the number that completes the pattern is 1!

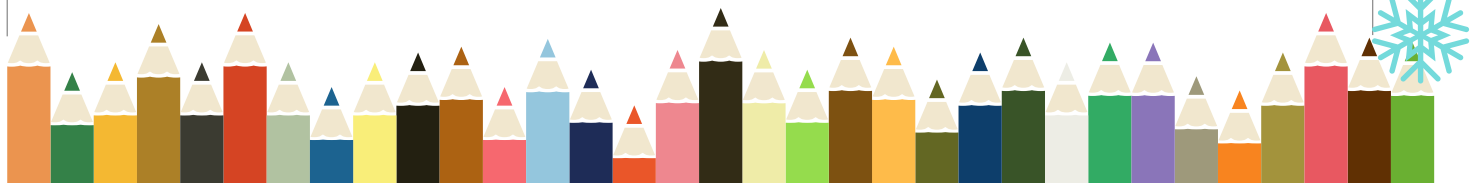

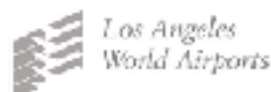
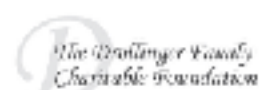
