*Here’s a card system our family uses at home. We work through 25 cards a week and we coordinate the cards to the lesson plan the teacher sends each week. I suppose it is actually 21 assignments because we’ve had to add in 2 -10min breaks and 2- activity cards as an incentive. The activity cards “with dots” are usually the “fun” activities like the LEGO challenge or cooking.*



Dear Parents,

Thank you for your interest in enrolling your child at Playa Vista Elementary School (PVES). Due to the growth in our community, we are only able to accept students who live within Playa Vista or are children of full time employees of Loyola Marymount University and have participated in LMU's lottery.

If you qualify to attend PVES, please fill out the enrollment paperwork found here. Your enrollment is contingent upon verification of the provided paperwork. **The enrollment process will begin as soon as the district tells us to proceed.** You will receive a congratulatory email once your enrollment is complete.

There are 10 PDFs in the enrollment package total. To complete the packet, please also include a copy of:

- **Proof of Age** – A copy of one of the following:
  - Birth Certificate (not hospital certificate)
  - Baptismal Certificate
  - Passport
  
- **Proof Residency** – A copy of your photo I.D. and a copy of one of the following:
  - Gas, Electric, or Water bill (not a telephone bill)
  - Rental or Lease Agreement
  - Property Tax Papers
  - Escrow Papers
  
- **Immunization Requirements** – All immunization records must be up to date to enroll
  - ✓ Polio – 4 doses required (Last does after age 4)
  - ✓ DTP – 5 doses required (Last does after age 4)
  - ✓ MMR – 2 doses required (Both after age 1)
  - ✓ Hepatitis B – Series of 3 does
  - ✓ Varicella – 2 doses (Chicken Pox – if child had the disease Doctor needs to stamp the card)

Once you have all the documents completed and the proof of age, residency, and immunizations, you may email them to Kristina Koffler at [kak9583@lausd.net](mailto:kak9583@lausd.net) or Jackie Nelson at [Jacqueline.nelson@lausd.net](mailto:Jacqueline.nelson@lausd.net). You may also drop the enrollment packet off at the school office on Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday between 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.

Remember that your enrollment is contingent upon verification of the provided paperwork. **The enrollment process will begin as soon as the district tells us to proceed.**

Thank you for your patience during these unusual times.
