Parent Volunteers are an important part of our PVES community.

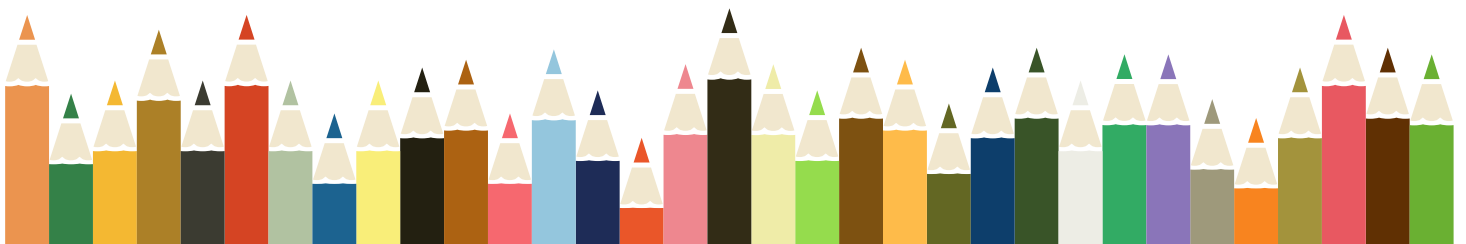
LAUSD is now requiring that all parents who wish to be in the classroom with students show proof of vaccination as well as a negative COVID test. If you are already vaccinated you simply need to upload your records. A **job aide on how to do that is attached** to this newsletter for your convenience.

If you have not yet been vaccinated, LAUSD has many locations where this service is being offered. You may visit <https://achieve.lausd.net/covidvaccineappt> for more information.

Parent volunteers may come onto the PVES campus to take a COVID test. Testing begins on Monday at 8:15 and goes until 2:15. The best time to come by is at 1:30 as students are usually done by then and there would be little or no line for you to wait in. You'll come through the office first and then go over to be tested in the MPR.

Remember that every adult entering the campus to volunteer in a classroom will need a Parent Daily Pass. This pass, as well as a Student Daily Pass, is connected to the Daily Dashboard and reflects updated vaccination and/or COVID testing records. A Guest Pass does not. That is why the words are in red. They alert those of us that are checking you in that the pass is not connected to the dashboard.

Beginning on Monday, those of you still using a Guest Pass will be asked the daily screening questions. Your child's name will also be checked against the Daily Pass Dashboard records. If you are not sure how to connect to the Student Daily Pass, please email me at Rebecca.johnson@lausd.net and I will be happy to assist you.

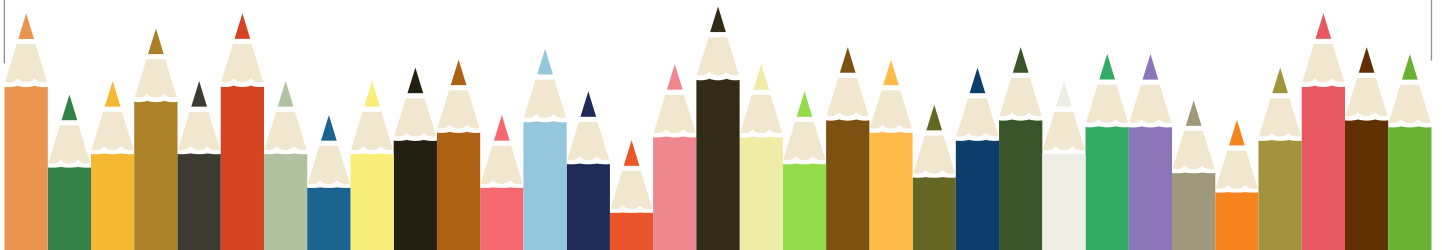
